## CORE VALUE STATEMENT – ENVIRONMENTAL

Alliance Technical Building Services Limited ('Alliance') acknowledges that its activities have an effect on the local, regional and global environment and that it has responsibilities under environmental legislation. As a socially responsible company Alliance fully accepts those responsibilities, and places the environment on equal importance to any other part of its business. As such the company has prepared the following statement including details of the organisation and arrangements in force for the carrying out of the policy. This policy applies to all aspects of its business.

Alliance is fully committed to its environmental management system and strives to demonstrate continual improvement of its environmental performance and helping its customers manage theirs through its services.

All members of the team at Alliance recognise that in their day-to-day activities they impact upon the environment in a number of ways including the use of refrigerants, the production of waste and emissions to air from transport. By impacting on the environment, the management and staff recognise the obligation to protect the local and wider environment in which the company operates. This obligation is reflected in Alliance's following commitments:

- The establishment and maintenance of an environmental management system.
- Will promote environmentally friendly or less harmful products to customers by providing information to those customers of the environmental impact of products at all stages of their life cycle from design, manufacturing, customer use and finally disposal.
- Will provide information and assistance to customers on environmental issues arising from its services as required.
- Will endeavour to minimise any negative impact on the environment including by its suppliers and sub-contractors.
- Will endeavour to continually improve its environmental performance, the prevention of pollution and encourage positive impacts on the environment by setting targets and goals.
- Recognises it has obligations in legislation and will comply with or exceed that legislation, to which the Company is bound in law.
- Shall take precautions to prevent releases to the environment, so far as is reasonably practicable and ensure that any releases to the environment that it makes are as low as is reasonably practicable, and in compliance with best practice and legislation as applicable.
- Provide sufficient levels of training to allow employees and contractors to meet their environmental responsibilities.
- Will communicate this policy to all of its employees, suppliers, sub-contractors, customers.
- Will make this policy available to the public.
- This policy will be reviewed annually.
